WOMAN'S CLUB TRANSFORMATION



For the past 18 months, a small group has been working diligently to save the Woman's Club from demolition. It was built in 1924 as an event space and hosted weddings, recitals, and meetings over the years. It is one of the few remaining historic buildings in New Smyrna Beach.

In mid-November, Curtis Hodges purchased the building as part of the Karter, Presley Lynaugh Trust with the proviso that the building be restored. Documentation of the restoration by King Star Filmworks began on November 24, 2024, with the long overdue new roof.
